Auction Rules and Procedures

Live Auction

There will be one Live Auction this evening. Bidding will begin at 9:10 p.m. In addition, a Live Auction may occur at the end of any of the category closings in order to resolve any bidding disputes (see "SILENT AUCTION" section below). Full descriptions of items offered for auction, including any restrictions, are available for review in front of the stage.

When a bidder is ready to make a bid, they simply raise their hand and the auctioneer or spotters acknowledge the bid. A bid cannot be revoked. The spotters assist the auctioneer in spotting bids.

Upon successful winning of the bid, the auctioneer tells the clerk what the bidder paid for the item. The winning bidder should approach the stage and provide the clerk with his/her name, phone number and bid number. This information is recorded and given to the cashier, who tabulates the bidder's purchases for checkout from the sale. The bidder then follows the procedures for payment as described below.

Silent Auction

All Silent Auction bidding begins at 6:00 p.m. when the doors open. The Silent Auction categories will close according to the schedule in this program and will be announced just prior to closing.

A bid sheet accompanies each item(s). The initial bid for each item shall be equal to or greater than the minimum bid as listed on the bid sheet for that item. Subsequent bids shall be in increments specified on the bid sheet. No bids will be accepted below the minimum. You may not withdraw your bid on an item and enter a new bid in a lower amount. Bid sheets may not be removed from the auction tables during the auction. Any bidder who removes a bid sheet or otherwise interferes with another person's ability to bid on an item while the auction is in progress will have his/her bid disqualified.

When bidding on an item, please print your full name, bid number, telephone number and bid amount on the bid sheet. Each new bid must be written in on the next blank line available on the bid sheet. At closing time, the highest qualifying bid (a bid that complies with auction rules) of the evening wins the privilege of purchasing that item(s). The final bid on each bid sheet will be circled by a

designated Big Red Auction official. Remember to check the final bid sheets for items on which you have placed bids during the evening to see if you have won.

No bidding is allowed after the closing for such items. In the event of a dispute, or if more than one person desires an item at the closing of a table, a Big Red Auction official may designate it as a Live Auction item. In such an event, the item will go to immediate live auction and the highest bidder will win. The payment and checkout room opens at 10:30 p.m. You may proceed to the checkout room at that time to pay for and retrieve items.

Payment and Item Pick-Up

All items must be paid for tonight, March 28, 2009. St. Edward School reserves the right to withdraw an item any time prior to the actual sale and payment of an item. All sales are final. No refunds or exchanges will be permitted. No item is redeemable for cash.

We will accept VISA, MasterCard, personal checks or cash at checkout time. Checks should be made payable to "St. Edward School Fundraising." A fee of \$25.00 will be charged for any checks that are returned for Non-Sufficient Funds (NSF). Any payments made before or after the official checkout time must be made via personal check or cash. If payment is not received the night of the auction, the payment must be received within three days after the auction has ended or the item will be awarded to the next highest bidder.

After paying for purchased items in the checkout room, the top bidders will be given a receipt. The cashiers will give out the items that are in the form of a gift certificate or tickets at the time of payment. After receiving their receipt, purchasers of physical items should proceed to the room where the auction items were on display for instructions on picking up their items. Purchasers must show paid receipt in order to pick up physical items.

Winners are encouraged to carry with them all items of manageable size; you are responsible for the safety and security of the item(s) after you have claimed them. All items must be removed from Buckley Hall by the end of the evening. The winner must make arrangements with a member of the Auction Checkout Committee in the event merchandise is too large to be transported that evening.

St. Edward School offers no warranty or guarantee and assumes no responsibility for the validity of the description, authenticity or condition of any

item offered. All services (trips, tickets, gift certificates, etc.) are subject to availability, unless otherwise stated. All auction items are sold "As Is" with no express or implied guarantees or warranties except those supplied by the donor or manufacturer.

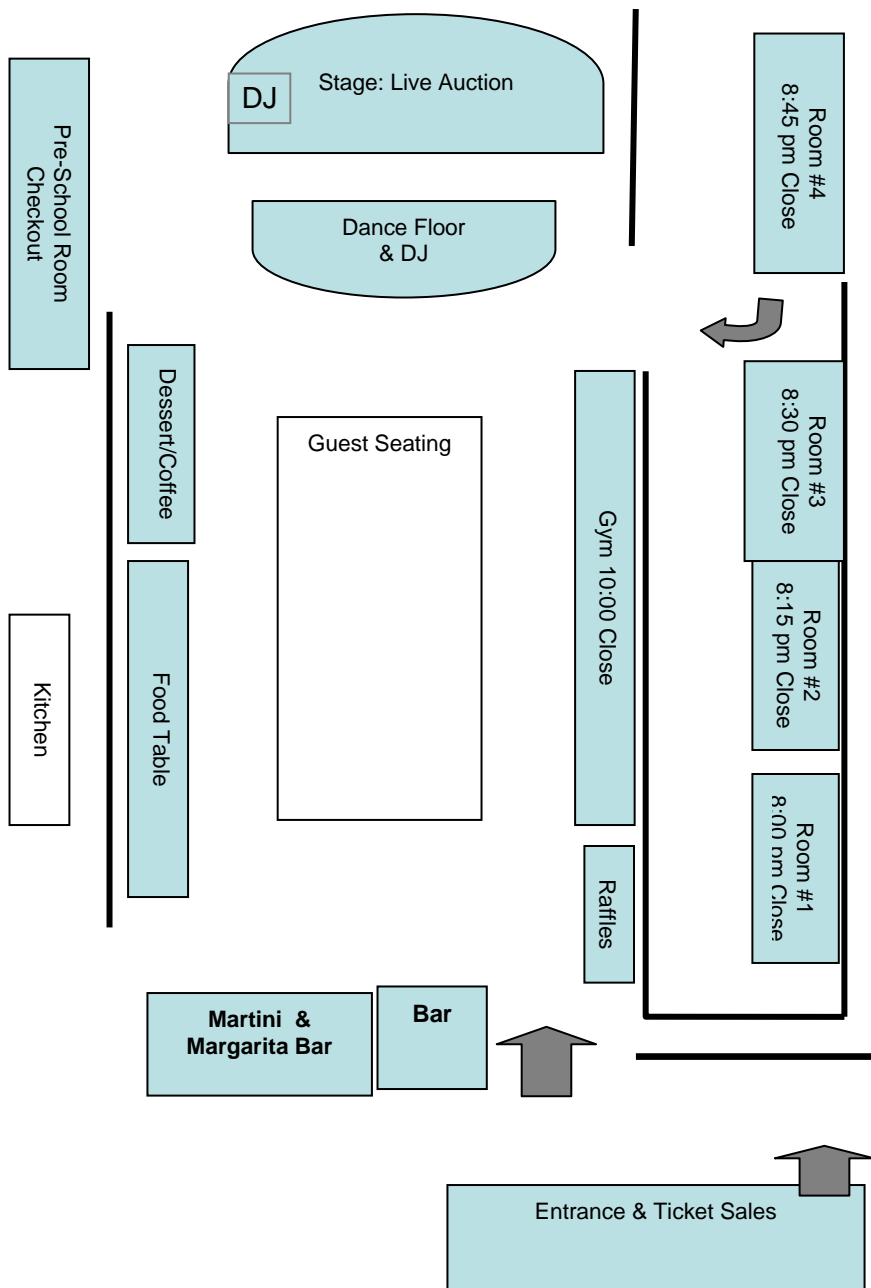
